**Indirect Support of Libraries:**

This consists of two components: 1) Services that are shared by all libraries; and 2) Services that are provided to specific, participating libraries

1) Services that are Shared by All Libraries: Examples include: POWER Library Chat with a Librarian service; POWER Library authentication services; One Book, Every Young Child; Summer Learning training for library staff, boards and friends; and scanning and preservation of rare and unique Pennsylvania library materials that are then made available from POWER Library and the Digital Public Library of America. Program costs are proportionally allocated to each county by population.

2) Services that are Provided to Specific, Participating Libraries: Examples include: Spark! (Pennsylvania Integrated Library System); Family Place; Cruise into Kindergarten; Teen Reading Lounge. These costs were assigned to those specific, participating libraries.

**Direct Support of Libraries:**

This category consists of grants that were made to specific libraries for new or improved services. Costs for these grants are assigned to the county in which the recipient library is located.

**Administrative and Operational Support:**

The amounts listed above do not include \$1.8 million in administrative and operational support provided by the Office of Commonwealth Libraries. This support includes staff to develop, coordinate and evaluate programs; provide professional development, advisory and reporting services; and provide outreach and rare collection support for the State Library.

**National Grants to Libraries, Educational Organizations and Individuals:**

The amounts listed above do not include grants made directly to Pennsylvania libraries, educational organizations and individuals by the Institute for Museum and Library Services (e.g. National Leadership Grants, Laura Bush 21st Century Librarian Program, etc.) These grants vary significantly each year. In 2015-16, grants in Pennsylvania totaled \$24,570; in 2016-17, grants were \$ 1,196,191.
